- Scheduled weekly care for parents to reduce stress and regroup

Starfish Children's Shelter | \$500, \$250, \$100, \$50, \$25, Other _____

- The only shelter, just for children, in Northern Utah up to a 30 day stay. Children ages 11 and under are placed here due to abuse, neglect or mistreatment. We provide a loving and safe environment for children transitioning into foster care

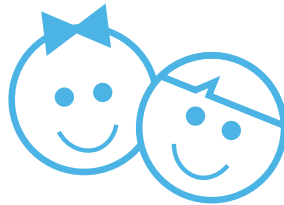
