PAINTED RAINBOW

MATERIALS:

- HALF OF A PAPER PLATE
- PAINT/MARKERS/CRAYONS
- COTTON BALLS
- GLUE



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. DRAW LINES ON PAPER PLATE TO CREATE OUTLINE OF RAINBOW
2. PAINT/COLOR THE COLORS ON THE RAINBOW
3. LET IT DRY THEN GLUE THE COTTON BALLS ON THE ENDS OF THE RAINBOW

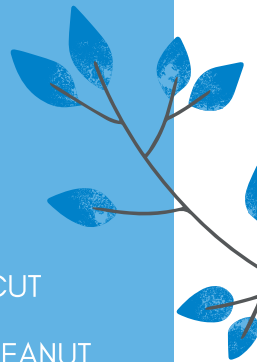
ANTS ON A LOG SNACK

INGREDIENTS:

- CELERY

INSTRUCTIONS:

HOW IS A RAINBOW MADE?

An easy explanation of the rainbow formation for kids is that the light that we see each day is sunlight, a white light that comes to us from the sun. White light is made up of the different colours that we see in the rainbow, but when the light is all travelling in one direction, it looks white. When the beam of light hits something, like raindrops, the beam divides into all of the pretty colors that we see in a rainbow!

FRUIT LOOP RAINBOW

MATERIALS:

- ONE SHEET OF BLANK PAPER
- ONE BOX OF FRUIT LOOPS
- HANDFUL OF COTTON BALLS
- GLUE

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. DRAW LINES ON PAPER TO CREATE OUTLINE OF RAINBOW
2. GLUE FRUIT LOOPS IN LINES
3. GLUE COTTON BALLS AT THE END OF THE RAINBOW
